THE BRAVE AND BEAUTIFUL QUEEN

1ST BRAVE LIGHT

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

- Glow Stick (1 per experience)

2ND SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: God makes me brave!

3RD QUESTIONS

age 4

- **Who is stronger than the dark?** *God*
- **Why can you be brave in the dark?** *God is stronger than the dark, and He's always with me to make me brave!*

BRAVE LIGHT

directions

1. Secretly **break** glow stick, **shake** it a bit, and **hold** it out of sight.

2. **Show** the glowing glow stick.

Say: Wow! Look what I have! It's like a night-light! You can hold one, too, like this!

3. **Teach** kids to make their own night-light: point the index finger of one hand up while wiggling the fingers of their other hand behind it.

Ask: I like my night-light—but do I *really* need a night-light to be brave in the dark?

4. Kids **respond:** *No*

Ask: Who can make us brave in the dark?

5. Kids **respond:** *God*

Say: You're right! I don't need a night-light because I know God is always with me. God is so much stronger than the dark! Let's hold up our night-lights and say, "God makes me brave!"

6. **Pick** a kid to **stand** in front of the group and **hold up** the glow stick.

7. When the kid **holds up** the glow stick, **help** the rest of the kids **hold up** their "night-lights" and **say**, "God makes me brave!"

Note: Use different voices to keep it fun each time.
For example: *whisper, shout, mouse voice, tiger voice, monkey voice, etc.*

8. **Repeat** steps 6-7 to **give turns** to as many kids as possible.

9. **Say** "Say With Me" listed on the front.

10. For age 4, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.
